

Bandstand Maintenance

The Big Question - How Often To Water?

Good question! The Bandstand flowers are primarily perennials, which should be watered 2 - 3 times per week, one way or another. If there is rain, that counts. We do have some annuals planted this year and these may need more frequent watering, especially in dry weather.

What To Bring:

Gardening gloves, container for weeds, gardening tools - clippers, etc.

Flower Care and Weeding:

Please dead-head the flowers, etc. and pull out weeds. Don't need to feed the plants.

Watering:

The hose is turned on by the Fire Department in May. Just turn on the water and you are all set to water the flower beds - early morning is best, evening is second choice, but whenever you can get there is good. Please roll up the hose, return it to its resting place and shut off the water.
